## 23rd International Conference on Nuclear Engineering ICONE-23

May 17-21, 2015 Makuhari Messe, Chiba, Japan

The 23rd International Conference on Nuclear Engineering (ICONE-23) will be conducted on May 17-21, 2015, Chiba, Japan. It is jointly organized by the Japan Society of Mechanical Engineers, American Society of Mechanical Engineers and Chinese Nuclear Society. This document describes outline of paper review, publication, how to prepare and submit your paper for the ICONE-23.

### 1. Outline of the Paper Flow Process

The Conference Toolbox is a web-based planning tool that allows organizers and potential authors to submit and manage their technical content online. Once authors submit papers, they initiate the process of reviewing and accepting technical papers for publication and presentation at the conference.

#### 1.1. Getting Start

Before you can hand in your paper on the site, you need to be sure you have a personal account. This account affords you the author level of access to. This account provides you with a login [your username (email address) and password].

#### Step 1: Abstract Submission by September 20, 2014

Authors should submit 400 word abstract (text only) with name, affiliation, address, phone, fax and e-mail information to the Web site. Please indicate the intended track. Manuscripts must be written in English. Once your abstract is submitted to the Web site your submittal will get automatically a paper number. Your paper number should be included on your draft and final papers. Please refer this number for easy tracking when making any conference inquiries.

On the Web page ([www.icone23.org](http://www.icone23.org)), your abstract will be reviewed and selected by peer review. You will receive the review result on **November, 2014**. The review status will be informed on ICONE-23 Web page. If you hope to know the status of your abstract/paper, please visit the Web page.

In the event the ICONE-23 organizers determine that your abstract is better suited for another area, they have the option to re-assign it. You will be notified by e-mail of any re-assignment.

#### Step 2: Submission of Full-Length Draft Paper for Review

Once your abstract has been accepted, you should submit full-length draft paper for review. We ask that you submit a copy of your draft with a PDF file on the Web site. Since the hardcopy of draft paper sent by ordinary mail will be not accepted, you are requested to submit the electronic version according to the format specifications described in the "*Format of full Paper*". A sample of full paper is provided on the website.

You will receive the review result on *January, 2015*. The review status will be informed on ICONE-23 Web page. If you hope to know the status of your draft paper, please visit the Web page.

### **Step 3: Submission of Final Paper and Copyright Transfer Form for Publication**

Once your draft paper is reviewed and approved, you may modify and complete your full paper and then submit your final paper for CD-ROM Publication. Again we ask that you submit a copy of final paper with a PDF file. Please confirm the final format specifications in the "*Format of full Paper*"

For the publication of your final paper we need the signed copyright transfer by *January 31, 2015*.

Deadlines are important in the process of organizing a successful conference. Please note if you do not submit your all materials by the deadlines, those may not be published in the CD-ROM. If there are any changes made to publication deadlines, please refer to the <http://www.icone23.org/>

## **2. Format of Full Paper**

In this section, we describe the format of the full paper. You can get information on paper size, margins, header, footer, fonts and so on. Please prepare your full paper after reading this section carefully.

### **2.1. General**

Manuscripts must be written in English. Paper should be double column, and single-spaced.

### **2.2. Structure of Paper**

The first page should be started by the title, the name, affiliation, address of each author. An abstract within 200 words should be followed to the title section. In abstract, please state briefly the purpose, method and results of the paper, followed by 5 or more keywords.

### **2.3. Page Layout**

Major specifications of page layout are summarized in Table 1. Here we just emphasize the references in detail. References should be cited giving the last name of the author and year of publication of the reference. The year should always be enclosed in parentheses. Whether or not name of the author should be enclosed within the parentheses depends on the context.

The two possibilities are illustrated below:

It was shown by Prusa (1983) that the width of the plume decreases under conditions.

or

It has been shown that the width of the plume decreases under conditions (Prusa, 1983).

Literature citations should be gathered at the end of the text. More than three authors, it can be represented by the first author and "et al." Author's family name should precede their initials or given name, and separated by a comma. Years of publication should be enclosed in parentheses. Journal article references should include author's name, journal title, volume number, initial page number and

year of publication. Book references should include author's name, book title, edition or volume number if any, publisher, city of publication, initial page number and year of publication. Report references should include author's name, report title (number) and year of publication. Proceeding references should include author's name, title of meeting, volume number if any, initial page number and year of publication. Title of journals and meetings can be abbreviated.

Please refer to following examples.

	Each table must have a descriptive title with 10 pt.
Equations	Numbered by Arabic numeral, like Eq. 1, Eq. 2.
